Peggy joined IMBEWU in May 2017 and provides legal advice on a range of environmental issues, including civil and criminal liability, compliance and enforcement action, environmental authorisation requirements, compliance with the Air Quality Act, greenhouse gas reporting, water use licensing, waste management and mining law. She also conducts due diligences, compiles appeals, undertakes environmental legal compliance audits and advises on the environmental aspects of commercial agreements.

Peggy has run a number of workshops on various developments in environmental law, including the Greenhouse Gas Reporting Regulations, the Listed Activities and Minimum Emission Standards under the Air Quality Act, the Climate Change Bill, the NEMA EIA Regulations and Listing Notices, the Gauteng EMF Standard, the Section 24G Fine Regulations, compliance with and enforcement of the Waste Act and lender liability.
