SECTION A: ENVIRONMENTAL (NATIONAL)

Agricultural Pests Act 36 of 1983 ("APA"):

1. Notice outlines revised phytosanitary control measures to prevent the introduction and spread of agricultural pests in South Africa. Published in GG 52750 NN 6224 dated 30 May 2025.

Electricity Regulation Act 4 of 2006 ("ERA"):

2. Notice outlines the regulatory framework for net-billing in South Africa, enabling Prosumers to export excess electricity to the grid and receive compensation. Published in GG 52781 NN 6262 dated 30 May 2025.

National Energy Regulator of South Africa ("NERSA"):

- 3. Notice provides a comprehensive framework for the financial and operational regulation of thirdparty wheeling (the process by which electricity generated by one party is delivered to another via the existing transmission or distribution network). Published in GG 52781 NN 6263 dated 30 May 2025.
- 4. Notice outlines how regulated entities in the energy sector must prepare and submit both financial and non-financial information to NERSA. Published in GG 52781 NN 6264 dated 30 May 2025.

Electricity Act 41 of 1987 ("EA"):

 Notice prescribes a levy of 0.13023 cents per kilowatt-hour (kWh) on all licenced generators of electricity who generate electricity for supply. The regulatory fee is effective from 1 April 2025 until 31 March 2026. Published in GG 52781 NN 6265 dated 30 May 2025.

Plant Breeders' Rights Act 12 of 2018 ("PBRA"):

- 6. Notice formally declares the effective date for the implementation of the Plant Breeders' Rights Act 12 of 2018, being 1 June 2025. Published in GG 52814 NN 6285 dated 6 June 2025.
- 7. Notice outlines the detailed regulatory framework for the implementation of the Act. Published in GG 52814 NN 6285 dated 6 June 2025.
- 8. Notice provides a comprehensive update on plant breeders' rights activities processed between October and December 2024. Published in GG 52883 NN 6324 dated 20 June 2025.
- 9. Notice provides an outline in respect of new applications for plant breeders' rights, grants, withdrawals, rejections and expirations of rights, as well as changes in ownership, agents, and denominations. Published in GG 52883 NN 6325 dated 20 June 2025.

Water Services Act 108 of 1997 ("WSA"):

24. Notice announces the initiation of an Environmental Authorisation (EA) application process for a major mining-related infrastructure development by Harmony Gold Mining Company Limited. Published in GG 52883 NN 3314 dated 20 June 2025.

National Heritage Resources Act 25 of 1999 ("NHRA"):

Limpopo Province

The Mopani District Municipality has issued a by-law titled "Mopani District Municipality Waste Management By-Laws, 2022" which provides a comprehensive legal framework for managing waste within the municipality. These by-laws are enacted under the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act 32 of 2000, and related legislation. Published in PG 3687 NN 1120 dated 13 June 2025.
- 38. The Mopani District Municipality has issued a by-law titled "Mopani District Municipality: Air Quality Management By-Law, 2022" which establishes a legal framework to regulate and manage air quality within the municipality's jurisdiction. These by-laws are enacted under the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act 32 of 2000, and related legislation. Published in PG 3687 NN 1121 dated 13 June 2025.
- 39. The Limpopo department of Economic Development, Environment and Tourism announces the formal declaration of Malachite Private Nature Reserve. Published in PG 3695 NN 1092 dated 27 June 2025.

North West
